1.6 Anatomical Terminology – Anatomy and Physiology

Standard anatomical terms of location deal unambiguously with the anatomy of animals, including humans.Terms used generally derive from Latin or Greek roots and used to describe something in its standard anatomical position.This position provides a definition of what is at the front ("anterior"), behind ("posterior") and so on.
